POLICY STATEMENT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL

Environmental protection is a management responsibility to which FRASER has a strong commitment to complying with legal requirements and with other requirements to which FRASER sub-scribes which relate to its environmental aspects, prevention of pollution and resources saving. Our environmental management system is focused on continual improvement in Source Reduction, Recycling / Reuse, Control and Disposal to making the earth polluted as little as possible. The following principals are basic to achieving the objective:

- a) Continuing provide sufficient resources and facilities for the implementation of waste management, noise and other environmental nuisance abatement;
- b) Obtain and renew the necessary environmental licenses, registrations and permits, and comply with the relevant statutory requirements and licensing standard;
- c) Adopt best practicable technologies and processes for implementation of environmental nuisance abatement during the course of our works;
- d) Communicate to all levels of person involved in the Works;
- e) Participating various type of trainings to enhance the knowledge in environmental protection;
- f) Ensuring the policy is documented, implemented and maintained;
- g) Make sure the policy available to the public;
- h) Encourage our staffs, suppliers and sub-contractors to accomplish the environmental duties;
- i) To share with our staffs, suppliers and sub-contractors about the experience on the environmental issues; and
- j) Environmental policy shall be reviewed annually and whenever necessary to ensure that it will be kept up to date.
